# SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS IMPORTANT

#### Did you know:

Section 7(1) of the *Education Act* states that every person who

- (a) is a resident of Alberta and has a parent who is a resident of Canada,
- (b) at September 1 in a year is 6 years of age or older, and
- (c) subject to subsection (2), is younger than 16 years of age,

shall attend school.

#### **Student responsibilities Section 31**

A student, as a partner in education, has the responsibility to

(a) attend school regularly and punctually

#### Parent responsibilities Section 32

A parent has the prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be provided to the parent's child, and as a partner in education, has the responsibility to

(c) ensure that the child attends school regularly,

(Education Act)

This means that it is the legal responsibility for all students to attend school regularly and punctually and for all parents to ensure their child/children attend school regularly and punctually.

There have been some issues with student attendance as well as punctuality. Parents will be notified by the principal if this is a concern. It is important to be at school regularly when feeling well and notify the school if your child will be away for any reason. This allows the student consistency of learning. Being on time for school is also crucial because many things happen within the first part of the day. It is optimal learning time. It is also disruptive to the rest of the students when a student enters class late.

Most importantly, the school and home need to work together for each student to experience successful learning. Please feel free to reach out to your child's teacher or school administration if you have any questions or concerns by calling the school at 780-478-3288.



## **REGISTRATION FOR 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR**

All students currently registered at St. Anne school do not need to complete an online registration again. If your child currently attends St. Anne School the process for enrolling your child for the 2022-2023 school year will involve two steps.

- 1. On January 23, 2023 all current families will be asked to complete pre-enrollment by filling out an INTENTIONS page in their PowerSchool account. This is when you will let the school know if you want your child to continue at St. Anne or if you would like them to move to another school (eg. moving homes or gr. 6 moving to Jr. High). All intentions must be received by March 1, 2023, through PowerSchool.
- 2. Once all intentions are complete the school will confirm your child's registration for the next school year via email. This will take place by April 2023.

All new Kindergarten students to St. Anne must complete an online registration form. If a parent currently has a child registered in Edmonton Catholic Schools, they can go into their PowerSchool account and register a new student. If a parent is new to Edmonton Catholic Schools, they can go to our school website at <a href="https://stanne.ecsd.net/">https://stanne.ecsd.net/</a> and click on the REGISTER NOW button to complete the registration form online.
